- **Basic Transport of Remains** (1 staff person) transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example: from the hospital to our premises, for distances not exceeding 40 km of the Funeral Home.

 (Additional Person Required for Transferring Remains \$125)
- Basic Documentation basic requirements of completing and filing of documents including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, Coroner's certificate for cremation. As part of this service, we will provide you with four (4) Proof of Death Certificates. Such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a Provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General.
- **Basic Support Staff Services** non-licensed funeral staff, such as completion of basic details, all relevant documentation, delivering permits, etc.
- **Necessary Care of Remains** (required facilities where basic preparation is provided) care of the remains for placement into the casket, setting of facial features for identification without embalming.
- **Basic Shelter of Remains** a monitored, refrigerated facility for Necessary Care of Remains.

Customary Documentation – includes, but is not limited to, producing numerous forms and documents that are required before, during, and after Ceremonies and Rites. Also included is the traditional green register book and 50 premium acknowledgement cards.

Partial Embalming of Remains – in addition to Necessary Care of Remains, which includes minimal embalming as well as bathing and dressing.

Full Embalming of Remains – replacing blood and bodily fluids with preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required within the Province of Ontario, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. However, should you wish to have an open casket for either private family viewing or public visitation, or should the funeral services be extended beyond 24 hours after the death, we suggest that this service be considered. For identification purposes, some partial preparations may be necessary. Your permission is obligatory. It is our company policy that if a body is present for visitation prior to a ceremony, full embalming is required.
